

Just to let you know, we've now undertaken scoring of the applications received in respect of the s106 funds from the King's Orchard developments, and agreed the allocations with the local ward members and portfolio holder. The allocations are as follows:

- £30,520 to Stoke Gabriel Boating Association for improving access between the DHNA pontoon and the foreshore at Mill Point, by the construction of an all-weather, all-states-of-the-tide link
- £5,000 to DCC for improvements to Stoke Gabriel footpath 6
- £8,550 to Stoke Gabriel Cricket Club for a new roof for the community pavilion
- £11,950 to Stoke Gabriel Cricket Club for a new office and ladies changing facilities
- £2,650 to Stoke Gabriel Cricket Club for improvements to the entrance road
- £12,720 to Stoke Gabriel Football Club for purchase of grounds maintenance equipment
- £13,233.60 to Stoke Gabriel Football Club to retrospectively fund their disabled access ramp
- £2,190.04 to Stoke Gabriel Football Club for improvements to their access road and car parks

“ The current funding allocations are based on the amount of secured funding as set out in the s106 agreement. We will receive some inflation on this and so we may be able to increase funding for this project when we know how much extra funding we will receive.

SHDC is yet to receive the funds from Cavanna Homes, which are due to be paid prior to occupation of 75% (40) of the dwellings. We understand from recent correspondence with Cavanna that they've currently got 37 dwellings occupied and are due to complete the project in October, with further occupations each month. We thus believe that they will reach the payment trigger relatively soon.

Once we receive the funds, we will issue the relevant groups with formal grant offer letters but all groups have been informed this morning of the proposed allocations.
